



DNTG 50th Anniversary Lip Balm Wrap



General Instructions

- This pattern is tubular peyote. You will bead around a Bert's Bee lip balm in a circular motion and "step-up" to the next row.
- The starting bead for this peyote pattern is the lower left corner. This means you will be beading **from left to right**.

Note: If you prefer to bead from right to left, once you have beaded the first 3 rows, flip your needle case upside down. You will now be beading "down" your needle case instead of "up" but you can still follow the pattern as it is written and bead from right to left.

- Beads used: **A** – Delica 167, Opaque Medium Blue AB
B – Delica 351, Matte White
C – Delica 410, Galvanized Yellow Gold
D – Delica 169, Opaque Chartreuse AB
E – Delica 249, Purple Ceylon
F – Delica 164, Opaque Turquoise Blue
G – Delica 163, Opaque Green AB
H – Delica 182, Silver Lined Jade Green

Beading Instructions

Rows 1-3 of these instructions explain how to start tubular peyote. If you haven't tried tubular peyote before, and want more information than provided, following is a link that has good instructions with photos on how to do this technique.

Let's Begin

- Cut a comfortable length of beading thread (36"-48"). Slightly pull the thread until the curl is out of the string. This is to strengthen your thread.

Note: If you do not pull your beading thread before beading, and have a heavy beaded piece, your thread can stretch over time and cause your piece to get loose or sag in places.

- Thread your needle and add on the beads for row 1 & 2 leaving a 6" tail.
-

Row 1 & 2:

String on 40A.

Make sure you count these twice before moving on to the next step. You don't want to make a mistake here.

Now thread your needle back through all of the beads on your string as well as an extra 2-3 beads. If you prefer, you can tie an overhand knot between the beads to secure your thread, but it is not necessary.

Row 3: (20B)

Slip your beaded circle onto a Bert's Bee lip balm.

String on 1B, skip the first bead, and thread your needle through the second bead on your string. The bead you just added, should sit on top of the 1st bead in your circle.

String on 1B, skip the next bead, and thread your needle through the following bead. Continue adding beads until you have all 20 done.

After putting on the last bead, you'll need to "step-up" to the next row by going through the 1st bead you added in row 3.

Your beaded piece should now look like the teeth on a zipper. To peyote, you add a bead to your string, thread your needle through the next bead that is standing up in the row. Your bead should "snap" into the open gap. At the end of a row, don't forget to "step-up" (through the first bead you put on in that row) to the next row.

Row 4: 20B (step-up)

Row 5: 2B, [1E, 3B] 4 times, 1E, 1B (step-up)

Row 6: 1B, [2E, 2B] 4 times, 2E, 1B (step-up)

Row 7: [3E, 1B] 5 times (step-up)

Row 8: [2E, 2B] 5 times (step-up)

Row 9: [1E, 1B, 1F, 1B, 1E, 1B, 1A, 1B] 2 times, 1E, 1B, 1A, 1B (step-up)

Remember to step up at the end of each row from 10-56

Row 10: 1B, [2F, 2B, 2A, 2B] 2 times, 2A, 1B

Row 11: [3F, 1B, 3A, 1B] 2 times, 3A, 1B

Row 12: [2F, 2B, 2A, 2B] 2 times, 2A, 2B

Row 13: [1F, 1B, 1D, 1B, 1A, 1B, 1D, 1B] 2 times, 1A, 1B, 1D, 1B

Row 14: 1B, [2D, 2B] 4 times, 2D, 1B

Row 15: [3D, 1B] 5 times

Row 16: [2D, 2B] 5 times

Row 17: [1D, 3B] 5 times

Row 18: 20B

Row 19: 1B, 1H, 18B

Row 20: 20B

Row 21: 1H, 6B, 1C, 12B

Row 22: 6B, 2C, 12B
Row 23: 7B, 1C, 1B, 1C, 9B, 1H
Row 24: 5B, 1C, 2B, 2C, 10B
Row 25: 6B, 2C, 1B, 1C, 8B, 1H, 1B
Row 26: 5B, 1C, 14B
Row 27: 4B, [1C, 1B] 2 times, 1C, 8B, 1H, 2B
Row 28: 3B, 1C, 16B
Row 29: 5B, 1C, 1B, 1C, 8B, 1H, 3B
Row 30: 2B, 1C, 2B, 2C, 13B
Row 31: 2B, 2C, 1B, 1C, 9B, 1H, 4B
Row 32: 1B, 2C, 17B
Row 33: 14B, 1H, 5B
Row 34: 20B
Row 35: 10B, 1F, 2B, 1H, 2B, 1F, 3B
Row 36: 9B, 2F, 4B, 2F, 3B
Row 37: 8B, 2F, 1E, 1B, 1H, 1B, 1E, 2F, 3B
Row 38: 7B, 3F, 1E, 2B, 1E, 3F, 3B
Row 39: 7B, 1F, 3A, 1H, 3A, 1F, 4B
Row 40: 7B, 1F, 6A, 1F, 5B
Row 41: 10B, 1H, 9B
Row 42: 9B, 2F, 9B
Row 43: 6B, 1F, 1D, 1F, 1H, 1F, 1D, 1F, 7B
Row 44: 5B, 1F, 2D, 2A, 2D, 1F, 7B
Row 45: 4B, 1F, 1D, 1F, 1B, 1H, 1B, 1F, 1D, 1F, 7B
Row 46: 3B, 3F, 1B, 2G, 1B, 3F, 7B

Row 47: 2B, 3F, 2B, 1H, 2B, 3F, 7B

Row 48: 1B, 4F, 1B, 2G, 1B, 4F, 7B

Row 49: 1B, 3F, 2B, 1H, 2B, 3F, 8B

Row 50: 1B, 2F, 6B, 2F, 9B

Row 51-54: 20B

Row 55-56: 20A

Weave your thread through all of the beads on row 55 and 56 again. Finish off your threads by weaving about an inch of thread through your beading.
