The Talented Turtles are planning a fun and relaxing 31st annual DN&TG ReTreat at Tanglewood Resort! The stitching room has been reserved, the menu planned, special gifts have been made, and surprises are in store!

Due to a change in Tanglewood management, **DN&TG must pay the hotel in full** prior to the event. As such, **your reservation will not be confirmed until receipt of your payment in full. For this reason the** <u>December 14, 2023</u> deadline will be a firm cutoff.

Additional items:

- Extend your stay by a day. Arrive on Tuesday, January 16th and enjoy a room rate of \$89, not included in registration.
- Tanglewood has contracted with **Pepsi** as their soft drink option throughout the property. Management is allowing retreatants to bring their own **Coca-Cola** brand drinks.

Sections of the necklace are created one at a time and connected to create one 78" long necklace and one shorter 18" necklace finished with a charm and drop focal piece. These ropes are really fun to create and there will be several kits to choose from including purple haze, ivory coast, and midnight clouds.

Technique: Bead Weaving Proficiency Level: Intermediate **Design Area:** 18" - 78" **Kit Cost:** \$125.00
