
Sampler Group

EGA Membership Renewal Changes

- Starting in 2024, all EGA members will renew their primary membership online.
- In May, primary DNTG chapter members will receive an email from EGA headquarters alerting you it's time to renew your membership. You then will be able to log onto www.egausa.org, visit the Chapter Map, select DNTG, and pay your national, region, and chapter dues. If you have a plural membership with another chapter, you will still need to pay the plural membership fee directly to that chapter for 2024.
- When you renew your membership online, you will have the option to set your membership renewal as a recurring payment. With this new feature, you will be able to have your membership auto-renew each year.
- New members can join anytime, and their renewal date will be one year after membership dues are paid on the last day of the month. For example, if you become a member on June 17, 2024, your next renewal date will be June 30, 2025.
