These ropes are really fun to create and there will be several kits to choose from including purple haze, ivory coast, and midnight clouds.

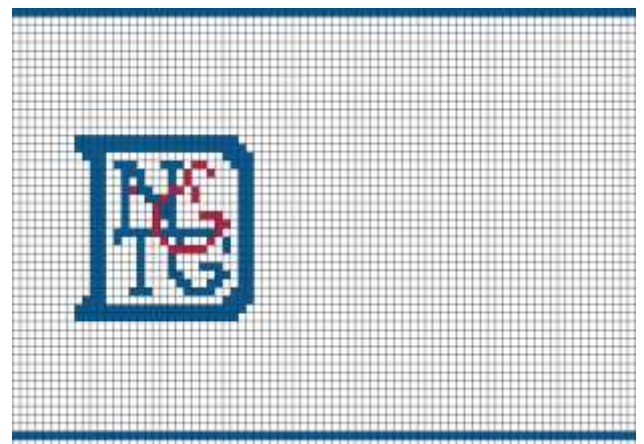
